Baptisms: Celebrated on the first Sunday of the month at 12:30 or 3:00pm. Parents should call the rectory at least four weeks in advance, and must attend instructions, which are held on the third Thursday of the month. Church Law requires that only Catholics in good standing are eligible to be Godparents. No Baptisms will be scheduled during Lent.

Anointing of the Sick: We offer this sacrament to those who are seriously ill, at home or in the hospital. We urge you to contact the office before someone goes to the hospital for an operation. (A priest may not be available later)

Ministry of the Sick: Holy Communion will be brought to the sick, upon request. The bedridden or chronically ill can be placed on the "Eucharistic Ministers" visitation schedule.

Wedding: Engaged couples must make arrangements in person, at the office at least six months in advance.

SEGUNDO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Hoy Isaías proclama la clase de Mesías que será el “Cordero de Dios” de Juan. La palabra “siervo” aparece tres veces en tres diferentes renglones, lo cual sugiere el ideal que debemos hacer nuestro. La prioridad de este Siervo es de hacer volver, congregar, restablecer y reunir a Israel. Pero la misión es más amplia: ser “luz de las naciones” y llevar la salvación “hasta los últimos rincones de la tierra”. Nosotros, “a quienes Dios santificó en Cristo Jesús” y que somos “su pueblo santo”, como nos describe Pablo, somos siervos de ese Siervo y tenemos que considerar nuestro rincón del mundo como uno de “los rincones de la tierra”, y por tanto hemos de planificar la manera de llevar “la gracia y la paz” a aquellos con quienes nos encontramos y que necesitan la luz y la ternura de Jesús.

La proclamación de Juan, que describe a Jesús como “el Cordero de Dios”, nos debe recordar que hemos sido salvados y alimentados, trascendiendo espacio y tiempo, y debe abrirnos a la eternidad, a la cual hemos sido remitidos por nuestra relación con Jesús, el Cordero de Dios: la liturgia de la Pascua (pasado) cumplida en Jesús, el verdadero Cordero Pascual que se ofrece incesantemente en la liturgia de la Eucaristía (presente) y que a la vez nos da un anticipo de la liturgia celestial (futuro).

Aún más reconfortante es que Jesús es “el Cordero de Dios, el que quita el pecado del mundo”.

Jesús le quita la carga a un mundo fracturado y nos invita a confiar en su compasión infinita, y a dejar en sus manos nuestra propia y multiplicada parte en esa fractura del mundo.
