**Baptisms:** Celebrated on the first Sunday of the month at 12:30 or 3:00pm. Parents should call the rectory at least four weeks in advance, and must attend instructions, which are held on the third Thursday of the month. Church Law requires that only Catholics in good standing are eligible to be Godparents. No Baptisms will be scheduled during Lent.

**Anointing of the Sick:** We offer this sacrament to those who are seriously ill, at home or in the hospital. We urge you to contact the office before someone goes to the hospital for an operation. (A priest may not be available later)

**Ministry of the Sick:** Holy Communion will be brought to the sick, upon request. The bedridden or chronically ill can be placed on the "Eucharistic Ministers" visitation schedule.

**Wedding:** Engaged couples must make arrangements in person, at the office at least six months in advance.

### **DÉCIMO SÉPTIMO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO**

La comunidad de Mateo, como la nuestra, se componía de variadas personalidades, que habían llegado por diferentes y dramáticos caminos. Para algunos, el Reino es un descubrimiento sorprendente, “un tesoro escondido en un campo”; para otros, una adquisición de gran valor asegurada después de una búsqueda meticulosa, “una perla muy valiosa”. Nosotros hasta tenemos un tercer grupo, desconocido para Mateo, los llamados “católicos de nacimiento”. No en balde la imagen de Jesús de “la red que los pescadores echan en el mar” suena tan verdadera.

Es así que el Evangelio de hoy repite la advertencia del domingo pasado. Si se nos ha olvidado que somos parte de ese conjunto mixto y nos imaginamos que estamos calificados o facultados para separar su contenido en “buenos” y “malos”, Jesús nos advierte que el juicio se pospone y la separación se aplaza hasta “al final de los tiempos”, y aun entonces no lo haremos nosotros: “vendrán los ángeles, separarán a los malos de los buenos”. ¿Qué sucedería si Dios se atreviera a ofrecernos lo que le ofreció a Salomón? Nosotros responderíamos con algo así como “¡Dame joyas ostentosas! ¡Una vida larga y feliz para mí! ¡Una vida más corta para aquellos que tengo en esa lista ‘especial’ que llevo años preparando!” ¿Suena muy severo? ¿O muy real? ¿Qué es lo que atesoramos? ¿“sabiduría de corazón [para poder] distinguir entre el bien y el mal”? Ante nosotros tenemos un tesoro vivo: es la Palabra que se hizo carne en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús.

“¿Han entendido todo esto?”, pregunta Jesús. Tal vez no lleguemos a entenderlo todo, pero podemos ofrecer sabiduría y “sacar cosas nuevas y cosas antiguas” (el Torá de Jesús y el Torá de Moisés) que ayuden a solucionar los dilemas de la vida. Y consideremos la gran riqueza que ya es nuestra: “predestinados, llamados, justificados y glorificados”.
